The Community Fund promotes healthy families by providing cancer support services, access to health care, therapy for children and families, mental health care and recovery from substance abuse.

Our state consistently ranks in the top 5 highest suicide rates. Suicide is the third leading cause of death for youth in the U.S. but the second leading cause in New Mexico.

Although some speech and hearing disabilities are congenital, they can also result from injury, disease or aging. Approximately 10,000 New Mexicans are deaf and 150,000 are hard of hearing.

Over 75,000 New Mexicans are currently living with cancer, and more than 9,000 new cases are diagnosed each year. Because New Mexico is a predominantly rural state, disparities in cancer care are a serious problem.

THE COMMUNITY FUND HELPS PROMOTE HEALTHY LIVES

- ✓ Provide about 14 educational presentations per month, creatively reaching about 10,000 people about crisis intervention services
- ✓ In one program, out of the 77 people qualifying for services, approximately 95% of them will receive hearing related diagnosis and treatment
- ✓ At least 160 unduplicated families will attend Fall 2010/Spring 2011 cancer support programs
- ✓ Provide support services to 560 cancer survivors and caregivers
- ✓ 100% of the crisis situation mental health/ substance abuse clients will be seen within 8 hours
