# SUPPORT EDUCATION

- ✓ Provide a safe and drug-free environment for 30 residents of the South Broadway area in a quality, caring after-school program
- ✓ Support 300 homeless children in the APS attendance area with after-school tutoring and 265 children through summer school
- ✓ In one program, at least 69% of middle-school students will maintain an A/B average or improve a below-B average in English language arts and 66% will do so in math
- ✓ Provide quality early childhood and therapeutic services to at least 105 children experiencing homelessness
- ✓ Immerse 1,500 children in vigorous movement classes to promote healthy choices, teamwork and academic achievement, improving fitness, nutrition and health knowledge, skills and behavior
