Impact in Valencia:

In Fall 2020, UWCNM held a digital video challenge for students in Valencia County, asking them to research a career and then create a video about what they learned. Five educators signed up as video mentors, the project generated 30 student videos, and a digital video library was created to include these videos as well as videos of local employers. A joint project with New Mexico Department of Workforce Solutions is now in the works.

In July 2021, UWCNM held our third annual Valencia County Summer Teacher Academy. Employers offered workshops for teachers on the skills they seek when hiring as well as the jobs in their local organizations. There were 49 participants plus 23 employees from 11 organizations offering presentations this year, with overwhelmingly positive reviews.
