

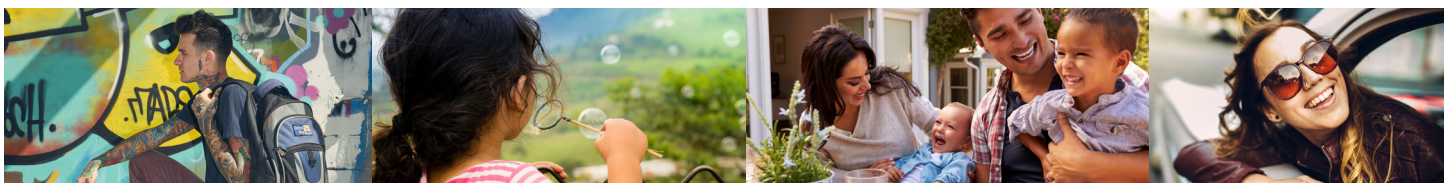
COMMUNITY INVESTMENTS
