What does a \$365 donation do? \$1 / day



- Provides 250 lbs of food for low-income students and their families (Assistance League)
- Five nights hotel stay, meals, and cell service for a survivor of interpersonal violence (DVRC)
- Supports child care related costs so parents can attend to their education (Saranam)

What does a \$1,825 donation do? \$5 / day



- Job placement for a person with a developmental or intellectual disability (Best Buddies)
- Special adult literacy materials and books (ReadWest)
- Attendance at a state leadership development conference for 45 students (Jobs for America Graduates-NM)

What does a \$52 donation do? \$1 / week



- Seven meals for someone homebound or experiencing food insecurity (Meals on Wheels)
- Nine pillows for residents undergoing medical care (Casa Esperanza)
- Sheet music for one Youth Musician for a year (NM Philharmonic)

What does a \$260 donation do? \$5 / week



- Shoes for eight students (APS Community Clothing Bank)
- Bus passes and transportation for a month for shelter guests (Family Promise)
- One hour of staff time for interns to facilitate a Family Science program (Explora)
