THE FAMILY ADVOCACY CENTER (FAC) IS MANY DIFFERENT AGENCIES WORKING TOGETHER UNDER ONE ROOF. THE UNIQUE DESIGN OF THE FACILITY DRAMATICALLY REDUCES THE STRESS AND TRAUMA OFTEN PLACED ON VICTIMS AND THEIR FAMILIES BY GIVING THEM ACCESS TO A WIDE RANGE OF SUPPORT SERVICES ALL AT A SINGLE LOCATION.
